The **Fayetteville Race Series** is a new program of Parks & Recreation. The series is comprised of six annual events that vary between running, cycling, and multisport activities. Each event is different and offers something for everyone! By offering the race series, Parks & Recreation aims to enhance the already active culture of the Northwest Arkansas area while also reaching new audiences. The race series began as a grassroots effort that we hope will grow into a premier race series for the state of Arkansas.

Frozen Toes Trail Run – Saturday, January 13, 2018

It might be cold, there might even be snow, but get out on the Mount Kessler trails and you'll warm up pretty quick! This 15k trail run is perfect for runners looking to transition from a 10k up to a longer race. New this year, we are offering a 15k Mountain bike race as well.

Square to Square Bike Ride – Saturday, May 12, 2018

Get out and explore the regional greenway with this bike ride from Fayetteville's square to Bentonville's square. 30 miles of fun that includes food, music, and great event swag!

Ladies Du Fayetteville – Sunday, June 10, 2018

Run 2 miles, Bike 11 miles, Run 2 miles around scenic Lake Fayetteville in this ladies duathlon. This is one of few ladies only events offered in the state and features swag and entertainment for a female crowd.

Square to Square Bike Ride – Saturday, September 22, 2018

Get out and explore the regional greenway with this bike ride from Bentonville's square to Fayetteville's square. This organized fun ride features festive post-ride activities for cyclists of all types.

Run for the Parks! – Sunday, November 18, 2018

Show your appreciation for parks and trails by participating in Run for the Parks. This race offers different distance options (8.5, 4.5, and 2.5 miles) each starting from a park along the paved trail system and finishing at Walker Park.

Cyclo Frost – Saturday, December 8, 2018

Cyclocross is a very specific type of bike racing. You can expect to encounter grass, dirt, mud, gravel, and a whole slew of other barriers and obstacles. Races are based on a set time (measured by numbers of laps), not distance.
