WHEREAS: we gather today in this school building designed for learning for generations to come:


- to celebrate the great partnership between the City of Fayetteville and Fayetteville Public Schools

“FAYETTEVILLE HIGH SCHOOL DEDICATION AND CELEBRATION DAY”


in Fayetteville, Arkansas and commend this observance to all our citizens.
