The Fayetteville Police Department is committed to assisting the citizens and visitors of Fayetteville in traveling its roadways in a safe and efficient manner. The total number of traffic violations cited decreased in 2019, and the number of motor vehicle collisions increased. Statistics regarding motor vehicle collision and various traffic violations are noted below.
