WHEREAS:

the Northwest Arkansas Free Health Center was founded by Jessie Bryant in 1986 with one volunteer physician, Dr. Liz Rantz, as a way to serve the uninsured, low-income residents of southeast Fayetteville, and

WHEREAS:

originally located in the basement of St. James Methodist Church, the increasing demand for services resulted in relocation to the basement of the armory building south of the Historic Washington County Courthouse in 1988 and then to the main floor of that building in the mid-1990's, and

WHEREAS:

in 2000 the NWAFHC had a budget of \$60,000 with 2 part-time staff, was open about 8 hours per week, and recorded 2,000 patient visits. By 2012, the Center provided 13,489 patient visits, was open 33 hours a week with 102 medical volunteers, 8 part-time and 2 full time employees with a budget of \$645,000, and

WHEREAS:

on January 15, 2013, NWAFHC moved into its new 10,000 sq. ft. space on Woolsey Avenue, expanding from 3 to 6 medical exam rooms, from 3 to 6 dental rooms, increasing hours of operation to 36 hours per week, and they are on target in 2016 to provide over 20,000 total patient visits, and

WHEREAS:

in September 2015, the Center's name was changed to WelcomeHealth, signifying that *everyone* is welcome and will be treated with dignity and respect regardless of their ability to pay,

WHEREAS:

now celebrating 30 years of service to our community,
WelcomeHealth serves the underinsured and the insured with
state-of-the art equipment and professional staff and volunteers,
and

WHEREAS:

the City of Fayetteville is honored to help celebrate this anniversary with WelcomeHealth and to express our appreciation for the services provided to our citizens throughout the past 30 years and for many years to come,

NOW THEREFORE, I, Lioneld Jordan, Mayor of the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas do hereby proclaim October 20 through 22, 2016 as
