WHEREAS: during the first 25 years of existence their work was concentrated in Fayetteville and helped institute the city's first animal services program and funded the construction of the first animal shelter jointly with the City of Fayetteville in 1965, and

WHEREAS: the Humane Society of the Ozarks has expanded to serve Northwest Arkansas and actively work to overcome the challenges causing animals to be abandoned, abused and overpopulated, and

WHEREAS: the Humane Society of the Ozarks continued to help improve animal welfare by helping to oversee some shelter operations, adoption efforts, fundraising events and by introducing a small educational program in the public schools, and



"Tails of Love Day"


in Fayetteville, Arkansas and encourage all citizens of this community to celebrate Tails of Love Day.
