Events Coming up in February and March for Fayetteville Entrepreneurs:

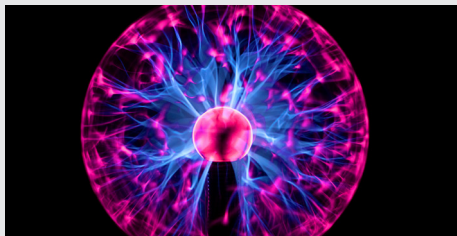
