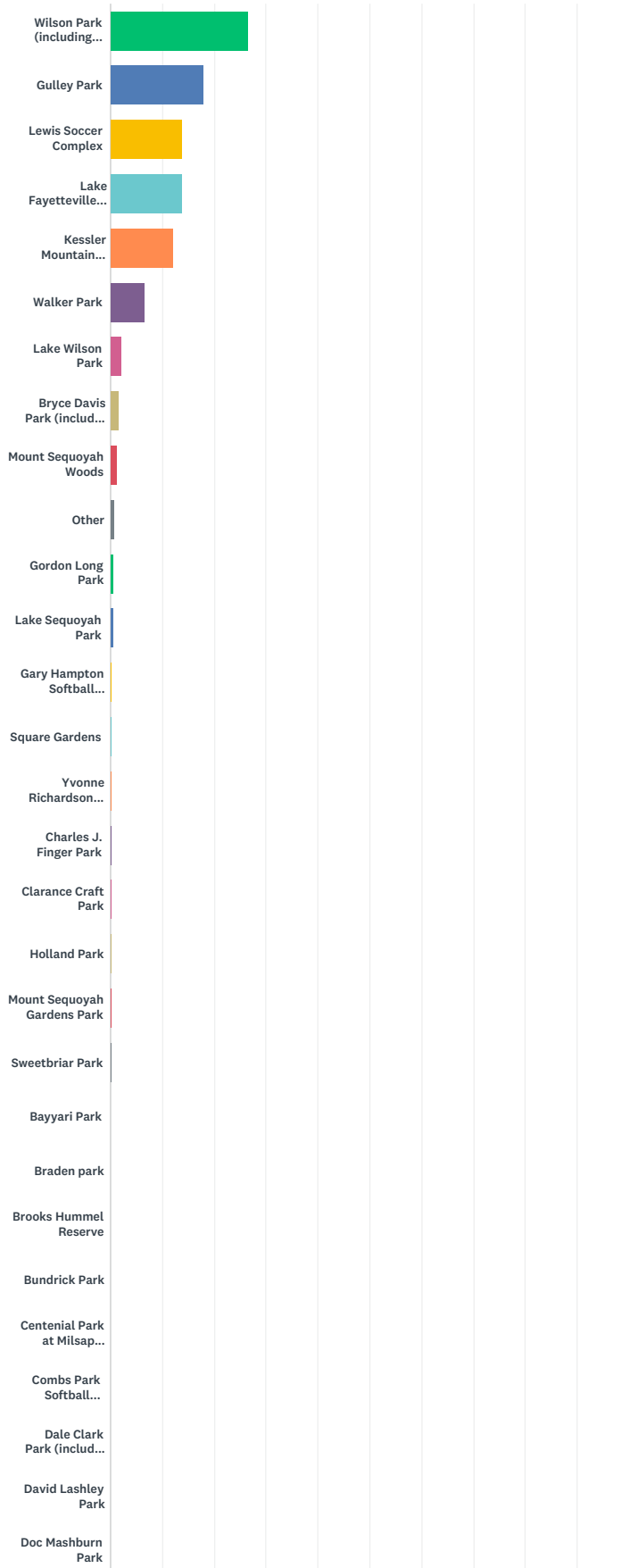
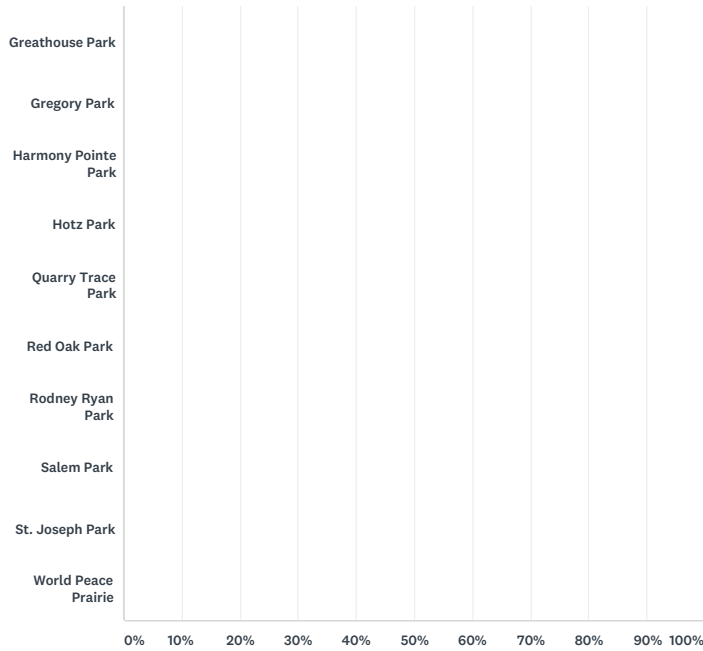

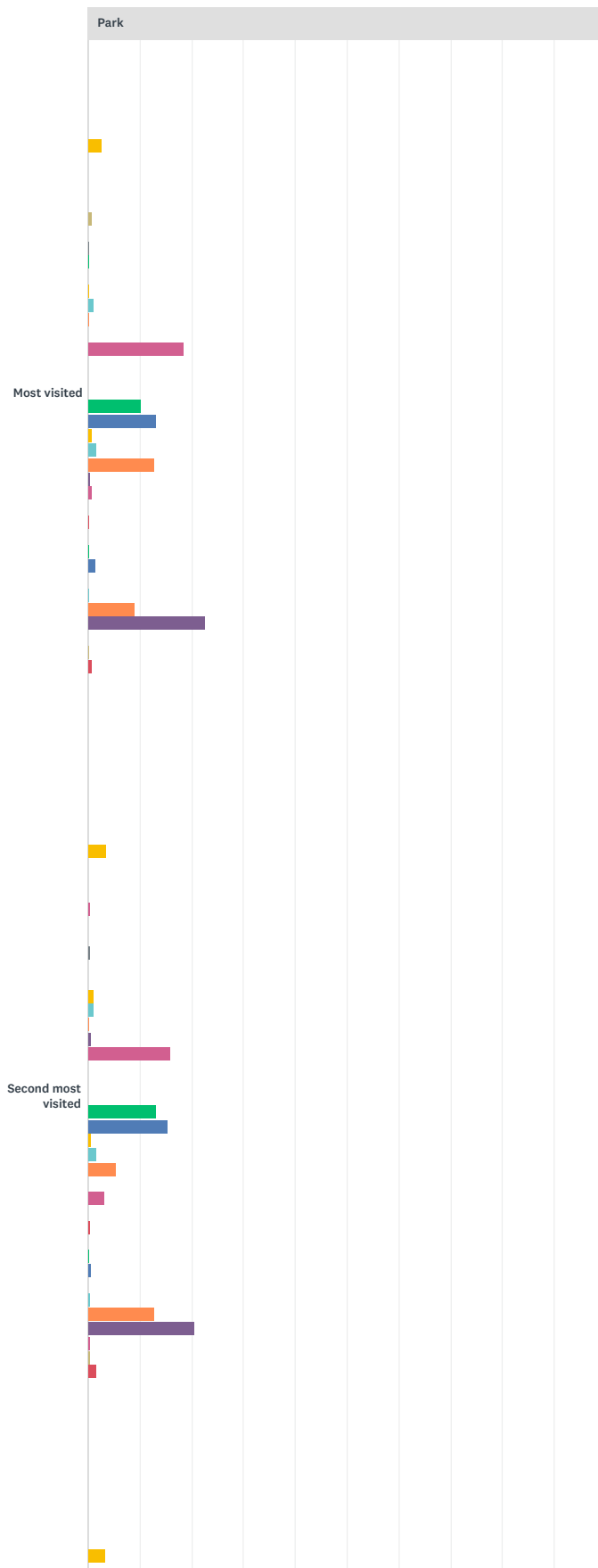

Q2 What do you like about your favorite park?

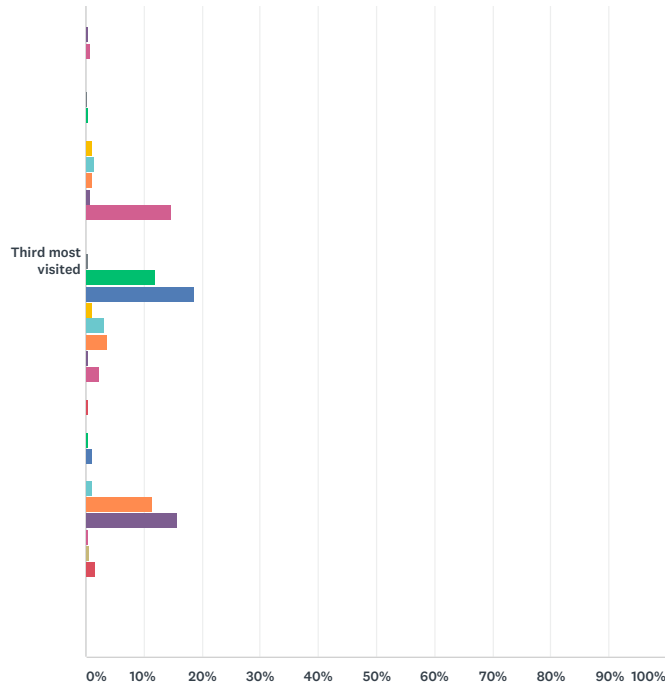

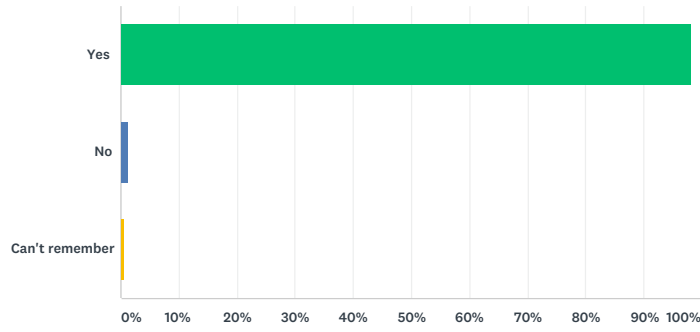

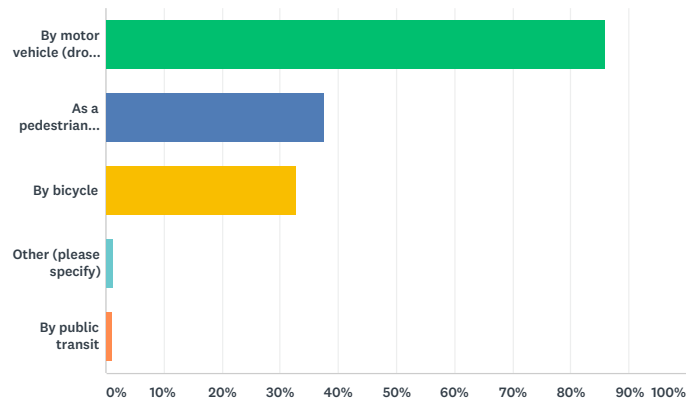

Q5 How did you get to the park?

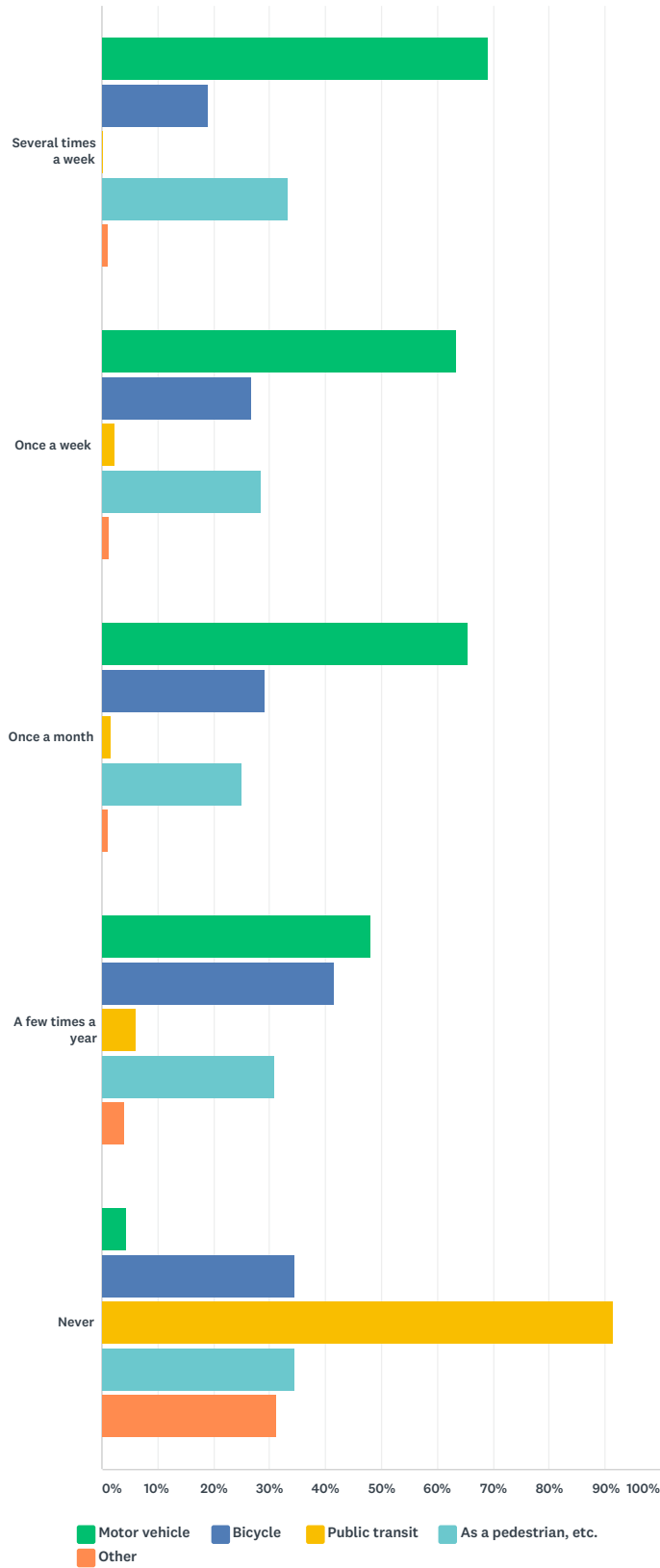

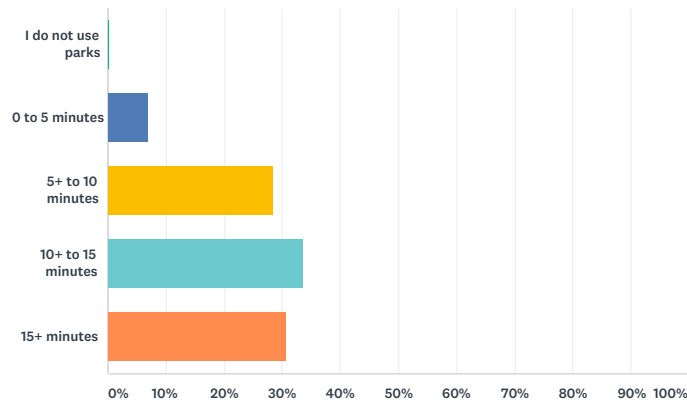

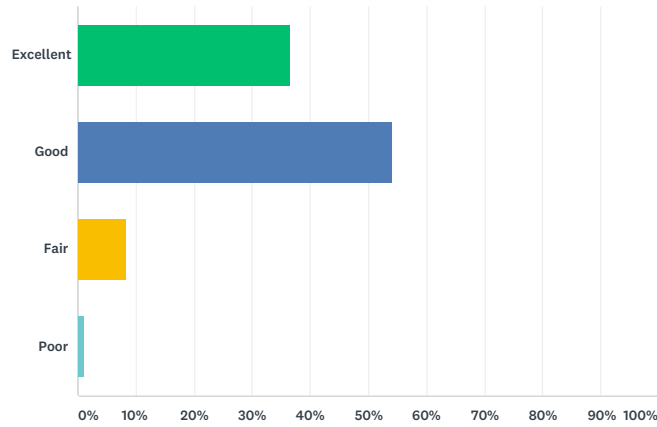

Q8 Of the Fayetteville parks you have visited, how would you rate their overall physical condition? (Please check only one)

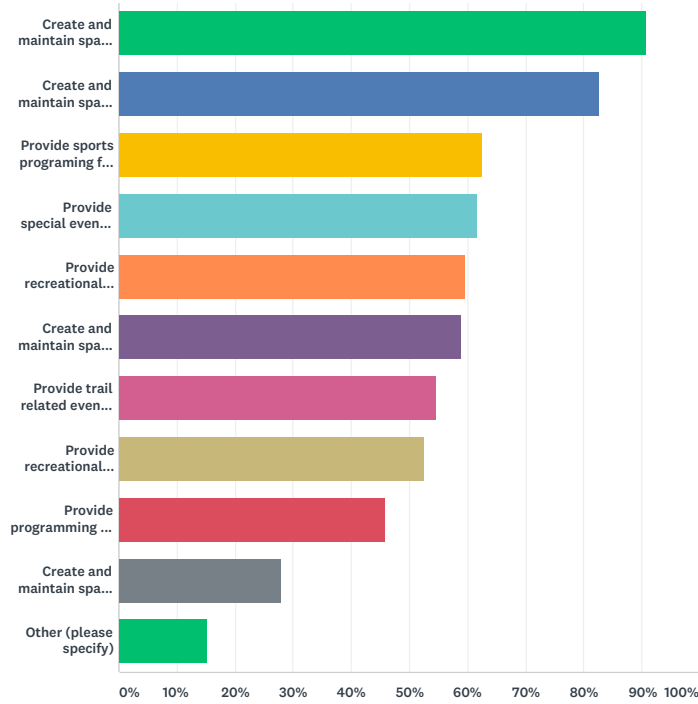

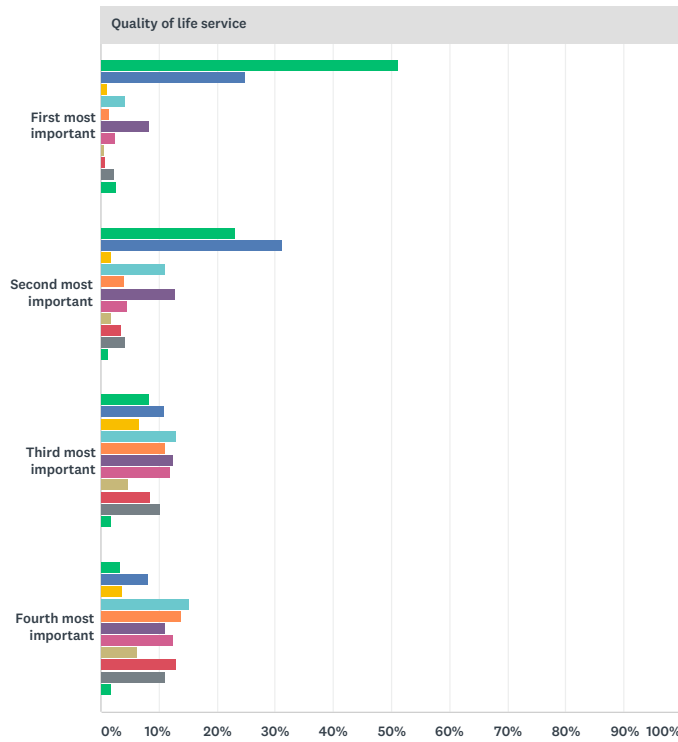

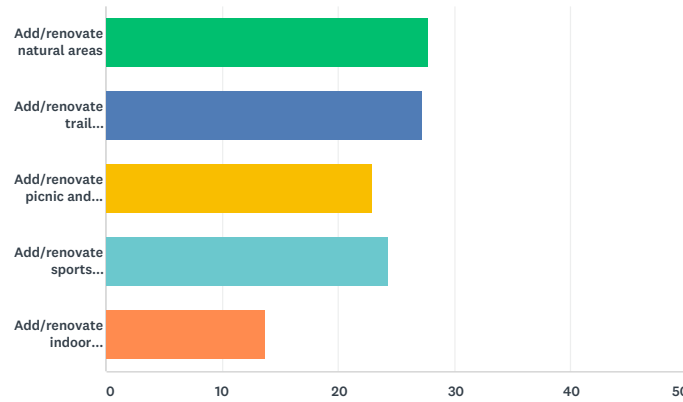

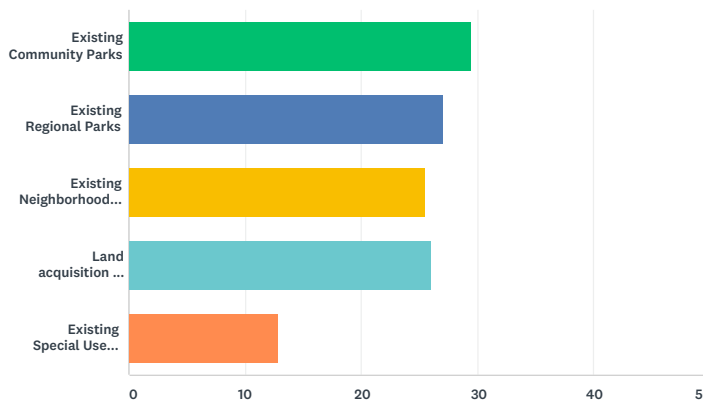
Neighborhood Parks: Smaller parks that serve a specific neighborhood and have limited facilities or recreational opportunities such as a picnic area or a playground. These parks sometimes have a natural area. For the purpose of this survey, we're including mini/pocket parks. Fayetteville's average neighborhood park is 6.3 acres in size.

Community Parks: Larger parks that provide a wide range of recreational opportunities for all generations. These parks are often unique and offer a destination that can entertain a family or group for a long outing. These parks service multiple neighborhoods and have a variety and combination of amenities such as disc golf, swimming pools, tennis and/or basketball courts, dog parks, picnic areas, splash pads. Fayetteville's Bryce Davis, Guley, Walker, and Wilson Parks average is 40.2 acres in size and are examples of Community Parks.

Regional Parks: Larger parks that have prominent outdoor recreation features (ball fields, hiking/biking trails, lakes, etc.). Regional parks, such as Kessler Mountain Regional Park, attract people from outside the city in addition to its resident population. Fayetteville's regional parks average 630 acres in size, are over 90% undeveloped, and make up 80% of Fayetteville's total parkland inventory.

Special Use Facilities: These are facilities, such as the Gary Hampton Softball Complex, that operate in a similar way to Regional Parks but are often focused on one facility that operates with fees. Along with use by the local community, these parks often attract people from out of town.

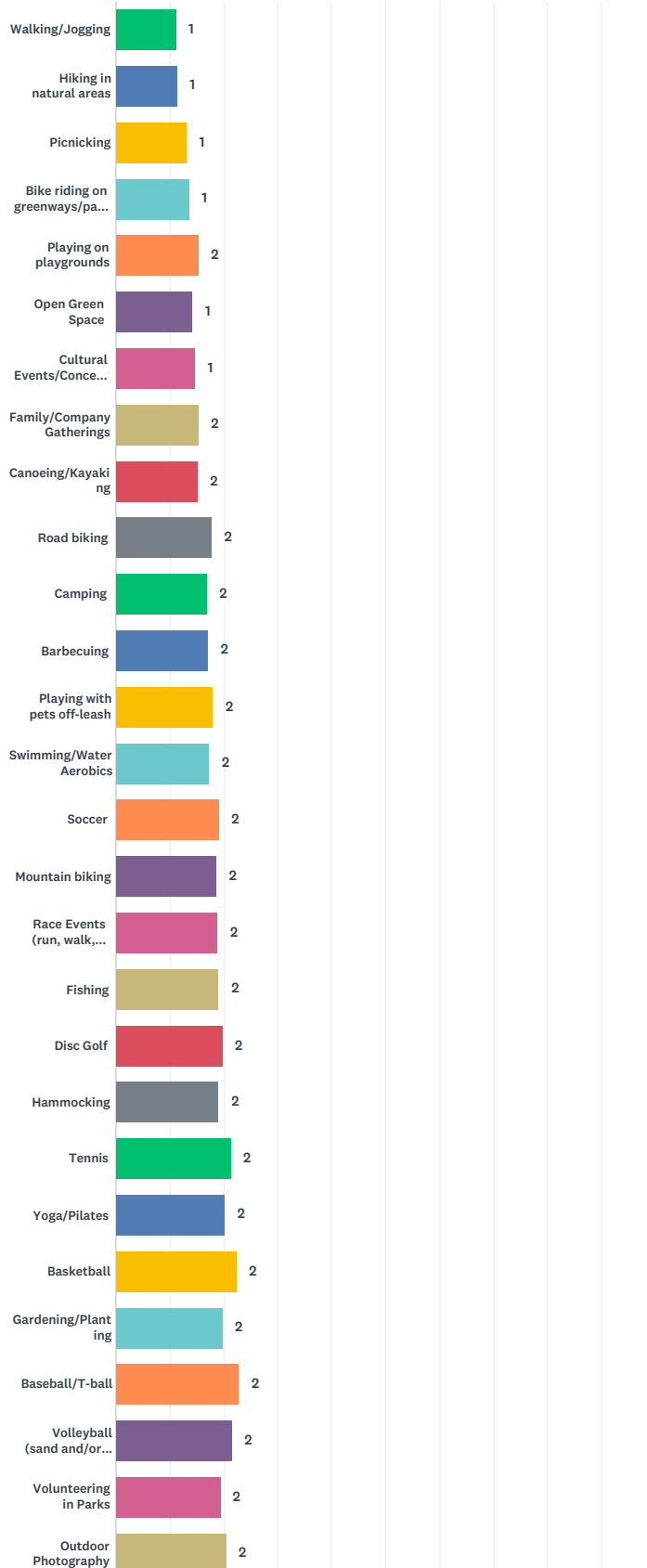

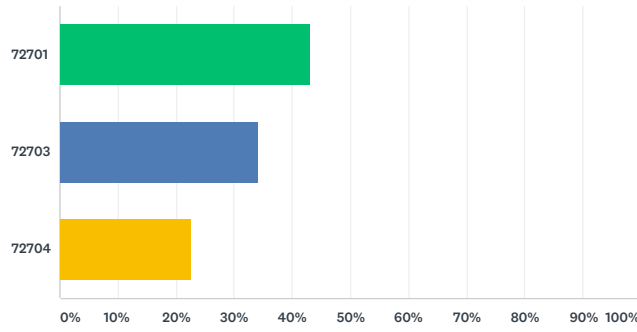

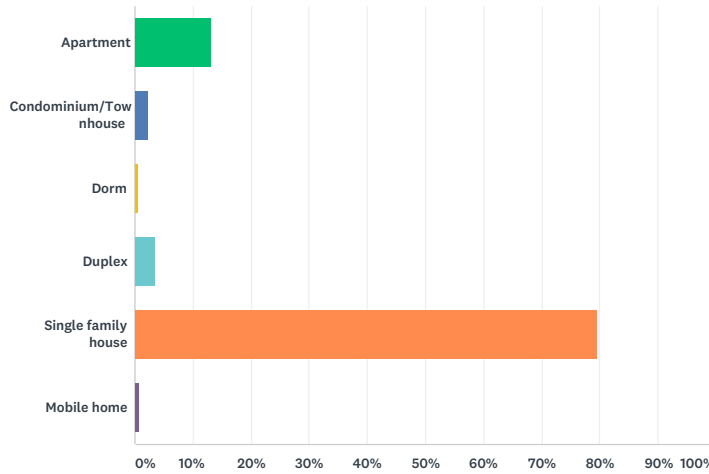

Q23 If you live in Fayetteville, what type of housing do you living in?

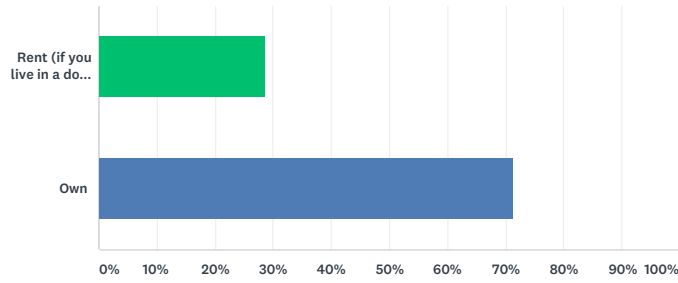
