

Timeline of Council Actions – Police Headquarters:

April 3, 2018 – PASSED Resolution approving a contract with Dewberry Architects, updating 2005 facilities need assessment for Fayetteville Police Department. The assessment included assessed needs for a firing range. Legistar item #2018-0170

Dec. 4, 2018 – PASSED Ordinance calling for special election including issuance of new bonds. Question 9 – Police Facilities Improvements. Ballot language included. *Legistar Item #2018-0651*

June 4, 2019 – PASSED Issuance up to \$142,670,000 for Phase 1 of 2019 Bond. Police Facilities Improvements spend noted at \$36,965,000. *Legistar item #2019-0307*

Sept. 3, 2019 – PASSED Resolution approving budget adjustment of \$134,588,625 to appropriate proceeds from 2019 city sales and use tax bonds for each of the nine bond questions, including Police Facilities Improvements.

Sept. 3, 2019 – PASSED Resolution authorizing approval of land sale agreement with University of Arkansas, 11.6 acres between Deane and Porter Roads for construction of Police Headquarters and Fire Station #8. *Legistar item #2019-0545*

Nov. 19, 2019 – PASSED Architect contract and project contingency for Police Headquarters and Support Facility. Packet included Dewberry space needs assessment specifying firing range needs. *Legistar Item #2019-0733*

Dec. 3, 2019 – PASSED Resolution for Construction Manager At Risk Services for Police Headquarters Phase 1. *Legistar Item #2019-0783*

Dec. 3, 2019 – PASSED Resolution amending land agreement with University for 11.6 acres (sewer line issue). *Legistar Item #2019-0833*
