Community Development Block Grant

HOUSING PROGRAM | provides housing-related repair & rehab services for qualifying low-to-moderate income families and individuals in order to preserve and improve their homes, creating a more livable home-environment while promoting housing that is safe, secure, healthy, and energy-efficient

HEARTH PROGRAM | provides housing services to individuals & families experiencing homelessness through *Permanent Supportive* housing

REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAM | established to assist low-to-moderate income residents in the City of Fayetteville by cleaning and revitalizing neighborhoods; the Redevelopment Program provides assistance in correcting certain Code Compliance violations

TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM | designed to provide low-to-moderate income, elderly, and disabled residents of Fayetteville with supplemental, alternative forms of transportation assistance:

Taxi Program - supplemental transportation reserved for disabled and/or elderly residents; monthly vouchers provided for participating taxi services

RANGER'S PANTRY PET FOOD BANK | assists low-to-moderate income families by providing dog & cat food in times of economic hardship

RANGER'S PANTRY ANIMEALS | assists Fayetteville seniors on the city's Meals on Wheels program by providing monthly supplies of pet food to homebound residents
