


# Youth Soccer COVID-19 Protocol

## TEAM SIDELINES

The home team and the opposing team will sit on opposite sides of the field. Parents, players, and coaches will all sit on one sideline with the opposing players, coaches, and spectators all being on the opposite side of the field. Family groups should distance themselves 6ft apart across the sidelines.

## SANITIZATION

We will be cleaning our facilities including restrooms' and high traffic touchpoints frequently. Hand sanitizer stations will be available at the soccer complex and we highly encourage sanitizing upon entry and exit of the facility.



## FACE MASKS

In alliance with the City of Fayetteville Mask Mandate, masks may be removed in outdoor settings generally while best practices to maintain social distance are followed. Masks shall be worn at managed events when attendance and format prevent social distancing.

Masks are encouraged for all attendees.



## DISTANCING & CONTACT

To minimize physical contact, high fives, hugs, and handshakes are discouraged. Use "Air Fives", foot bumps, or verbal congratulations instead!

Post-game "good game lines" will not take place. Instead opposing teams will congratulate each other from across the field verbally.

## COVID PRE-SCREENING

Coaches, Players, Spectators and Staff should pre-screen themselves BEFORE arriving to the facility. Ask yourself the following questions and in the event you or your family member can answer YES to ANY of these questions, please leave the facility immediately.

- Have you had a fever of 100+ in the past (2) days?
- Do you have a cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, or loss of smell or taste?
- Have you had any contact with a person known to be infected with COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
- Are you waiting on the results of a test for COVID-19?
- Have you had a positive COVID-19 test in the last 10 days?

IN THE EVENT AN INDIVIDUAL ANSWERS YES TO ANY OF THESE QUESTIONS, THEY MUST LEAVE IMMEDIATELY
