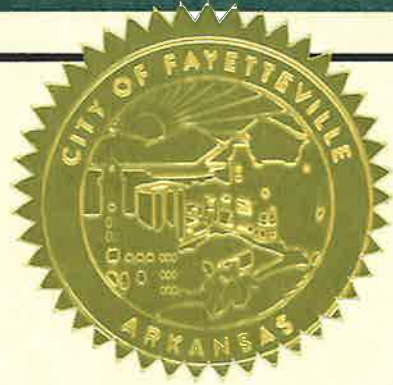

**Proclamation**



**WHEREAS:** methamphetamine is currently the greatest drug threat in the State of Arkansas and has reached epidemic proportions in Northwest Arkansas; overwhelming Federal, State and local law enforcement agencies, and

**WHEREAS:** methamphetamine is one of the most powerful and dangerous drugs available, being easy to make, highly addictive, highly volatile, and producing vast amounts of environmental waste, and

**WHEREAS:** methamphetamine destroys everything it touches: homes, families and lives, and

**WHEREAS:** the struggle against methamphetamine is not a problem solely for law enforcement but is a problem for all of the State of Arkansas and the City of Fayetteville, and

**WHEREAS:** the only way to impact a citywide problem is to attack it with every resident's assistance and commitment to help solve this problem, and


**WHEREAS:** every individual living in Fayetteville can help stop the epidemic spread of methamphetamine.
