Proclamation




- WHEREAS:** over 30 years ago the members of Living Faith Pentecostal Church of God did begin a fundraising campaign to build a new worship sanctuary and did raise over \$250,000.00 in eight years, and
- WHEREAS:** on the date of August 30, 1999 and after much prayer, the church acquired a loan of \$602,250.00 to complete construction of the worship sanctuary, and
- WHEREAS:** said worship sanctuary, with a present certified value of \$2,875,987.00 still had a remaining debt of \$144,123.01, and
- WHEREAS:** in September of 2014, the church began a debt reduction campaign, called UNLEASED, to pay off the remainder of the loan and on December 9, 2015, two and a half years ahead of loan maturity date, the loan was paid in full, and
- WHEREAS:** Living Faith Pentecostal Church of God, being DEBT FREE is poised to make an even stronger spiritual and charitable impact in the community of Fayetteville, and
- WHEREAS:** it is appropriate that we celebrate 16 years of worship and community service in this sanctuary and we express our appreciation and pride that this building will remain a symbol where faith and life connect together in worship and service,

NOW THEREFORE, I, Lioneld Jordan, Mayor of the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas do hereby proclaim Sunday, January 24, 2016 as
